Class Teachers

Please:

- Always set homework and set on the night specified.
- Instruct pupils to get their student planners out and check they are using them.
- Avoid setting "finish classwork" as homework tasks.
- Avoid setting homework in the final few minutes.
- Allow more than 24 hours for the completion of homework whenever possible.
- Discuss within department good homework tasks.

Note:

- a) Homework for Music will be set as required.
- b) For those learning an instrument it is expected that they practise every day for a minimum of 20 minutes.
- c) Pupils not taking Spanish only have one piece of language homework.
- d) ICT homeworks in Y7 and Y8 are about 20 minutes each.

Length of Homework Tasks

A Year 7 homework task should last about 30 minutes per subject.

A Year 8 homework task should last about 35 minutes per subject.

A Year 9 homework task should last about 40 minutes.

A Year 10/Year 11 homework should last about 60 minutes per subject.

Please note that the student planner provides information for parents as much as for pupils. For parents to support their child's learning they need to know what homework is being set. **For this reason we require tutors to get pupils to fill in the subjects a term in advance and to monitor the completion of the planner regularly.**
